Equipment and Materials for State Contest

**1. Supplied by the technical committee-**

- a. All necessary materials, workstations, and power tools needed to complete each project except for those listed below.

**2. Supplied by the contestant-**

- a. Nail apron/tool pouch
- b. Claw hammer
- c. Measuring tape
- d. Framing square
- e. Two pencils
- f. Utility knife
- g. Countersink set, 3 pcs, #6, #8, #10
- h. Small drill bit set
- i. One center punch/nail set
- j. One magnetic bit holder
- k. 2-#2 Philips bits
- l. 2-T15 Torx bits
- m. Sanding Block
- n. Three 8 1/2" x 11" pieces of sandpaper (100, 150, 220 grit)
- o. Small putty knife
- p. One set of flat blade and Philips- head screwdrivers or screwdriver with interchangeable bits.
- q. Corded or Cordless drill.
- r. Heavy Duty 14/3 50' extension cord if corded drill is brought. Otherwise not needed.
- s. Calculator
- t. Additional tools are optional but not required.
- u. All competitors must create/submit a one-page, typed, resume and submit a hard copy to the contest chair at the beginning of the contest. Failure to do so will result in a penalty.

**3. Attire-**

Professional attire is expected. Collared short sleeve shirt, long pants, work boots, safety glasses or goggles, (prescription glasses can be worn if they carry the Z87 rating and are equipped with side shields. If not they must be covered by goggles.)
