1. What makes you stand-out above other applicants?

3. You and your partner respond to a motor vehicle accident. You arrive to find two patients. Your partner attends to one patient and you attend to the other who is walking around. Your patient refuses to let you help him and wants you to leave him alone. How would you handle this patient?
4. Why do you want this job?
5. What would you do if you knew that a co-worker was injured playing softball, while off-duty, then came to work and staged a pretend fall and claimed that the injury occurred on the job.
6. You respond to a call for an elderly woman with respiratory problems who lives by herself. Due to her medical condition she needs to be seen at the hospital by a doctor but she is afraid to leave her house unattended due to a recent spree of robberies in the neighborhood. How would you handle this?
7. You report to work at the fire station and notice that your partner appears to have been drinking prior to reporting for duty. He is acting in an unusual way and you can smell alcohol on his breath. How would you handle this situation?
8. You have been assigned to a station for about 6 months. There is a senior member on the shift that is not helping with housework duties. What would you do?
